

## **FAQ ABOUT WATER SKI DAYS**

### **CARNIVAL:**

#### *Where can I get pre-sale carnival tickets?*

Fiesta Foods, Snyder Drug, & The Lake City Chamber of Commerce all have pre-sale tickets available for sale during their normal hours beginning the second week in June up until Water Ski Days weekend.

#### *What is “Family Day” at the Carnival?*

Family Day is where you are encouraged to bring the whole family down to the Carnival to go on rides. Every ride requires ONE LESS ticket than usual! For example: If a ride usually takes 3 tickets; it would only take 2 during the “Family Day” time.

#### *How many tickets does each carnival ride take?*

Each carnival ride requires between 2-4 tickets, depending on the ride. Family Day requires one less ticket per ride.

#### *When is the carnival open?*

The carnival is open starting at 1pm on the Friday of Water Ski Days. It is open most of the days and evenings through Sunday night, depending on weather and other stipulations. “Family Day” is from 1-6pm on the Friday when it opens.

### **FOOD BOOTHS:**

#### *When do the food booths open?*

**Patton Park Food Booths** are open from 9am-5pm on Saturday and Sunday.

The **Beer Tent Food Booths** are open on Friday from 4-midnight, Saturday from 11am-midnight, and Sunday from 11am-10pm.

### **BEER TENT:**

#### *When is the Beer Tent open?*

The Beer Tent is open for serving, from 4-midnight on Friday, 11am-midnight on Saturday, and 3pm-10pm on Sunday.

### **PARADE:**

#### *Where is the parade route?*

The parade route starts from the Football Field on Iowa & Garden St. and goes North on Garden St. for 9 blocks; then East on Center St. for 2 blocks; North on High St. for 5 blocks; West on Woodburn St. for 3 blocks, ending at McCahill Ball Park.
